

DATA FROM ELIZABETH CITY COUNTY TAX RECORDS (Cont.) 1815-1850. (3/23/74)

Property B - 100 acres, originally part of George Wythe's Chesterville (800 acres), later divided by Holder Hudgins, Sr. when he gave 700 acres to his daughter and kept 100 for himself.

Property C - 200 acres, the Syms School Land, bought by Holder Hudgins, Sr. in 1809.

Property E - Chesterville Plantation, 700 acres in 1815.

Property F - Originally 225 acres, part of the original 285 Moore Patent.

Property G - 50 acres, originally part of the Moore Patent (called Wm. Moore tract)

Property H - 50 acres, the Mallory Ross Land (1782).
