

DEED - GEORGE WYTHE TO J. WALLACE - 28 JAN. 1802 Eliz. City County Deeds &
Wills 1796-1806, Book 12, Reel 8

Be it known that i George Wythe of the City of Richmond to whom a small parcel
of land part of point Comfort in the County of Elizabeth City had been granted by
letters patent, and who had given one Moiety (half) of the said parcel to James
Wallace deceased do hereby release to the representative of the said James Wallace
who would have been intituled if a conveyance to the said James Wallace had been
sealed and delivered by me all my right and title in and to the Moiety aforesaid.
In witness whereof i have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the twenty eighth
day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two.
