

WHEREAS by instrument dated March 2, 1939, permission, revocable at will by the Secretary of War, was granted to the National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics to use and occupy Plot No. 16 and other portions of the Langley Field Military Reservation, Virginia, for the purpose of constructing, using, operating and maintaining thereon, buildings, structures and utilities necessary in scientific research and experiments in the problems of flight, as indicated on the National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics drawing No. X-6400, last revision dated October 1, 1940; and

WHEREAS the said instrument was amended on August 23, 1939; October 30, 1939; February 3, 1940; February 27, 1940; May 8, 1940; July 11, 1940; October 3, 1940; April 23, 1941; February 28, 1942; October 18, 1943; and December 13, 1944 to grant the permittee permission to use and occupy an additional area on said reservation; to construct certain additional buildings and structures described in said amendments; to make connections to the Langley Field water system and to take therefrom quantities of water for the permittee's activities at Langley Field; to install, operate and maintain an electric power cable and a telephone cable; to remove a dirt road and construct another road in lieu thereof on said reservation; to increase the length of the second seaplane towing tank authorized by the Amendment of April 23, 1941; to relinquish a portion of the area covered by amendment dated August 23, 1939; and to grant the permittee permission to use and occupy an additional area on said reservation.

WHEREAS the National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics has now made application for permission to use and occupy a portion of Area "B" on Langley Field, approximately 23.46 acres, (part of which was relinquished by amendment of October 18, 1943), for the purpose of constructing certain facilities thereon.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE SECRETARY OF WAR further amends the said instrument dated March 2, 1939, as amended, to grant permission to the

of the Langley Field Military Reservation, Virginia, designated as area "B" in the location shown substantially in red on photostat of map attached hereto and made a part thereof, together with the right to construct certain facilities upon land within said area "B".

IN ALL OTHER RESPECTS the provisions and conditions of the original instrument of March 2, 1939, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect and shall be made applicable to this amendment.
