To all etc Whereas etc Now Know yee that I the said Sr Wm Berkeley Knt doe with the Advice and Consent of the Councill of State Accordingly give and grant unto John Howitt of the County of Elizabeth City Carphenter two hundred and four Acres of Land Situate lyeing and being in the said County on the Southerne side of the ould Poquoson river and adjoining Easterly on the Land late of George Hull and westerly on a Neck called Barrows his Neck Northerly upon the said Poquoson river and Southerly into the Maine Woods the said two hundred and four acres of Land being part of a patent of five hundred Acres of Land granted unto John Laydon dated the 3rd day of October 1638 Noe More being to be found by the Surveyors and now purchased by the said John Howitt and the patent being in his possession. To have and to hold etc to be held etc yeilding etc which payment is to beginn Seven years after the date of the 3rd of 8ber 1638 Dated the first June 1648.
