

JOHN LAYDON - PATENT RENEWAL FOR 500 ACRES
South of the Old Poquoson River

Dated 3 October 1638 - Patent Book 1, page 620

To all to whome these presents shall come I Sir John Harvey Kt. Governour
etc send etc whereas etc Now know yee that I the said Sir John Harvey
Kt. doe with the consent of the Councell of State accordingly give and
grant unto John Laydon five hundred acres of Land situate lying and
being in the Countie of Elizabeth Citty at the old Poquoson lying by a
neck called Burrowes his neck bearing Eastward from it alsoe Joyning
to the land now in the possession of Georg Hull bounding west from it
South up into the woods and North upon the old Poquoson river The
said five hundred acres of Land being due unto him the said John Layden
upon a consideracon expressed in an order of Court bearing date the 29th
day of February 1631 To have and to hold etc dated the third day
of October 1638 ut in alijs
