

AMENDMENT TO PERMIT
Contract No. DA-44-110-ENG-4299

WHEREAS, by Permit dated 2 March 1939, permission, revocable at will by the then Secretary of War, was granted to the National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics to use and occupy Plot No. 16 and other portions of the Langley Air Force Base Military Reservation, Virginia (formerly known as Langley Field), for the purpose of constructing, using, operating and maintaining thereon, buildings, structures and utilities necessary in scientific research and experiments in the problems of flight; and

WHEREAS, the said instrument was amended on 23 August and 30 October 1939; 3 and 27 February, 8 May, 11 July and 3 October 1940; 23 April 1941; 28 February 1942; 18 October 1943; 13 December 1944; 6 August 1945; 20 February 1948; 5 August 1949; 3 October 1950; 31 July 1952; 12 December 1957; 3 January 1963; 13 February 1964; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Transfer Order No. 14, jurisdiction of the property involved was transferred from the Secretary of the Army and the Department of the Army to the jurisdiction of the Secretary of the Air Force and the Department of the Air Force, effective 1 July 1948; and


WHEREAS, the Air Force has a need for 15.57 acres of the permitted lands for use in connection with construction, operation and maintenance of the base golf course and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (formerly National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics) is willing to release the said 15.57 acres:

NOW, THEREFORE, the aforesaid permit, dated 2 March 1939, as amended, is further amended as follows:

To delete from the permitted areas that parcel of land containing 15.57 acres, more or less, being the easternmost portions of Parcel "B1" and Parcel "G", as shown and delineated in red on map marked Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

IN ALL OTHER RESPECTS, the provisions and conditions of the original permit dated 2 March 1939, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
