AMENDMENT TO PERMIT

WHEREAS by instrument dated 2 March 1939, permission, revocable at will by the then Secretary of War, was granted to the National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics to use and occupy Plot No. 16 and other portions of the Langley Air Force Base, Virginia, for the purpose of constructing, using, operating and maintaining thereon, buildings, structures and utilities necessary in scientific research and experiments in the problems of flight, and

WHEREAS the said instrument was amended on 23 August and 30 October 1939; 33 and 27 February, 8 May, 11 July and 3 October 1940; 23 April 1941; 28 February 1942; 18 October 1943; 13 December 1944; 56 August 1945, and 20 February 1948, to increase and decrease the areas authorized to be used, and to grant the permittee additional rights and privileges under the permit,

NOW, THEREFORE, the aforesaid instrument of 2 March 1939 is further amended as follows:

1. To authorize the use of two additional parcels of land, as shown substantially in red on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, and described as follows:

a. Approximately 18 acres of land along the southeasternmost "H" boundary of property presently occupied by the NACA at the Langley Air Force Base, to be used by the NACA as a part of the site for a new hangar; and 21.33

b. Approximately 43 acres of land along the northeasternmost "G" boundary of property presently occupied by the NACA at the Langley Air Force Base, desired by the NACA for considerations of safety in the proposed construction of rocket storage and shop buildings for pilotless aircraft. 35.98

2. To include in the permit a provision that the class and quantity of rockets and explosives to be stored in the area should comply and be in accordance with Ordnance Safety Manual, O.O. Form No. 7224, 3 May 1945 and TM 9-1900, 18 June 1945, to the extent that use of adjacent Air Force property will not be jeopardized.

IN ALL OTHER RESPECTS the provisions and conditions of the original instrument of 2 March 1939, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect and shall be made applicable to this amendment.
