On Sept 12, 1765 Francis Mallory and Jane his wife deeded to Abraham Allen, house carpenter, for thirty pounds an estimated ten acres of land "bounded from the Main Back River Road as it now stands, westerly along the line of William Smith's land up to a maple corner tree between the said Smith and John Armistead, and then turning northerly along the line of John Armistead's land for a small distance, then turning easterly adjoining John Allen Junr down to the aforesaid main road. The said land being lately the property of John Allen Junr which Francis Mallory hath lately obtained a deed from the said John, and all houses, orchards, gardens, wood trees, way, water courses and other appertinances - -"

F. Mallory acknowledged receipt of thirty pounds from Abraham Allen on same date.
