president of their Ma'ties Councill of State of Virginia send greetings in our
Lord God Everlasting. Whereas Quintillian Gutherick of this Collony dyeing and
leaving an Estate in divers goods in Case whereof Ann Gutherick his relict hath
made humble suite to the Court that a Comission of Administration might be
Granted her of the s'd Estate Now know yee that I the s'd Nathaniel Baccon ^{President} etc
according to an order of Eliza. Citty County Court bearing date the 18th of
November 1689 for the better securing & ordering of the s'd Estate doe give
and Grant under the s'd Ann Guthericke the Administration of all & Singular
the Goods rights & Credits of the estate of the s'd dec'd of what Quality or
Condition they be, or in whose Custody soever they remayne within the Collony
and doe by these presents further Order & apoint that the s'd Ann Guthericke
shall present unto the Justices at the s'd County of Eliza. Citty at the next
Court a true & perfect Inventory of the s'd Estate being lawfully apraised by
Sufficient men upon Oath & further that she satisfy & pay all such debts as
remayne due & owing from the s'd Estate unto any person or persons within the
Collony & after such debts are p'd that then the s'd Ann Gutherick bring a true
and Just acc't of the surplusage or remaneder of the s'd Estate when she shall be
thereunto lawfully Called and deliver the same unto the Justices for the use of
such person or persons unto whome of right it shall belong or apertayne Given
under my hand & the Seale of the Collony at James Citty Aprill the 21st Ano.
