

WILLIAM MALLORY - PATENT CONFIRMATION FOR 274 A.

To all etc whereas etc Now know yee that I the sd Edward Nott Esqr Gov etc do with the advice and consent of the Councill of State accordingly gives and grant unto Mr Wm Mallory two hundred seventy four acres of land situate and being in the County of Eliz City and beginning at a pine and running from thence youth four hundred and two poles into the woods to a gum thence East ninety eight poles to a white oake thence North four hundred poles to the head of a branch thence down the sd branch to the mouth thereof where it falleth into old Poquoson River so up the sd River to the pine first above menconed joyning westerly on the land of Mr. Anth'y Armestead Southerly on the land of Mr John Persons and Easterly on the land of the heirs of Mr. Tho Wyth decd two hundred acres part thereof was granted by pattent to Wm Moore bearing date the 29th day of October 1662 and <sup>after</sup> several Conveyances and assignments comes to the sd Wm Mallory the Residue is waste Land and is due unto the sd Wm Mallory by and for the transportation of two persons into this Colony whose names are to be in the Records mencon'd and or this Patent To have and to hold etc To be held etc Yeilding and paying etc provided etc Given unto my hand and the seale of the Colony this second Day of May Anno Dom 1706
