Trustees Symm's School vs G. W. Sweeney

At a meeting of the Governors and Trustees of Sym's Free School in Elizabeth City County on Thursday the 28th of July in the year of our Lord 1791. Present The Revd. Mr. Henry Skyrin (Rector) George Wray, George Booker, George Hope, Cary Selden, Robert Brough & Michael King. Order'd, that, the Sheriff distrain on the Plantation of George Wythe, Esq., for Seventeen Pounds, fifteen Shillings & eight pence; being the balance due to William Seymour for his services as Master of Sym's Free School for the year 1790, and pay the same to said Seymour or his Order; unless the money be paid on or before the 25th day of August next.
