

DEED OF GIFT - ANN WYTHE TO FRANCIS MALLORY

Elizabeth City County Records 1689-1699; Reel 1, page 181

This bindeth me Anne Wyth my heirs Execut'rs and Adm'rs well and truly to pay or cause to be paid unto my grandson Francis Mallory his heirs Execut'rs or Adm'rs or any of them the full sume of Forty p'ds sterl. by bills of exchange. The first bill to be past the first day of May in the yeare one thousand six hundred ninety and seven for twenty p'ds sterl. and the second bill to be past the first day of May in the yeare one thousand six hundred ninty and eight for twenty p'ds sterl. In Wittness whereof I sett my hand and seale this nineteenth day of November 1695.
