Dear Sir:

At the verbal request of your command, we are enclosing herewith, for transmittal through channels, eight prints of drawing LB-2236, showing the parcel of land involved in the subject request, as follows:

Starting at a concrete monument on the east edge of Ames Road (NACA taxi strip), which monument is 2000 feet north of the centerline of runway 25-7 and about 490 feet south of the south edge of the NACA Flight Research Hangar Storage Apron, and running 1737.70 feet parallel to the centerline of runway 25-7 (S 66° 17 min. 34 sec. W) to a concrete monument, thence 302.78 feet S 9° 22 min. 30 sec. E to a concrete monument, thence 1574.93 feet parallel to the centerline of runway 25-7 (N 66° 17 min. 34 sec. E), thence 324.33 feet N 29° 12 min. 30 sec. E to a point on the east edge of Ames Road, thence 100 feet along the east edge of Ames Road, (N 35° 47 min. 30 sec. W) to the point of beginning, comprising 11.47 acres more or less.

We trust that this information will help to expedite approval of the subject request.
